SchoolFood4Change is taking part in the BIOFACH forum from February 11-14, 2025. This event, known as the World Leading Trade Fair for Organic Food, brought together the international organic community. Concurrently, the BIOFACH Congress 2025 was held under the motto “Yes, we do! - How to effect change in the organic food segment.” This congress serves as a central platform for dialogue and knowledge exchange on innovative solutions and the shift towards more organic practices.

On February 12th, SchoolFood4Change will host a session organized by ICLEI Europe, in collaboration with WWF Sweden, IFOAM Organics Europe, and the city of Nuremberg. We will explore the policy framework for school meals in Europe and celebrate 10 success stories from schools and cities across the EU during the “*SchoolFood4Change EU Awards Ceremony*”. The finalists, whose innovative efforts have set new standards in sustainable school food practices, will be unveiled on February 12th at BIOFACH.

SchoolFood4Change:

The EU-funded project SchoolFood4Change was launched in January 2022, SchoolFood4Change aims at engaging schools as catalysts for a transformation towards a sustainable food system. Therefore, the 43 organisations from 12 European countries, coordinated by ICLEI - Local Governments for Sustainability, bring all relevant school food actors to one table: students, parents and teachers, farmers, chefs and canteen staff, sustainable food procurement experts, dietitians, and local enterprises. The heart of the project is a three-fold approach that includes sustainable food procurement, the implementation of planetary health diets and the holistic “Whole School Food Approach”. SchoolFood4Change is funded by the European Union’s Horizon 2020 programme. It started in January 2022 and will run for four years. Findings will be replicable within and beyond the EU
